CalEITC

The CalEITC is a cash back tax credit for workers. Claiming the CalEITC does not affect other benefits your client can receive.

Young Child Tax Credit

The Young Child Tax Credit (YCTC) is a NEW California credit. Families with at least one child under age 6 can get up to an additional \$1,000 cash back when they file their 2019 taxes.

CalFresh

CalFresh is California's food nutrition program, formerly known as food stamps. Once approved, families receive an EBT card with money for groceries.
